

First Things First...


For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23

We have all seen them, heard them, and even fell for them. They look so good; they sound so promising; they are too good to be true! (And that means, they <u>ARE</u> too good to be true.) "They" are BOGO, 50% off today only, pay \$39.99 get a second one free! inventory is running low -buy yours before they are gone, you only pay a small handling and shipping fee...and other scams/questionable sales practices/tricky reading/tiny, tiny, tiny fine print.

The secular adage: 'there ain't no such thing as a free lunch," is thought to have originated in the 1930s when saloon and bar owners would advertise a "free lunch" to entice customers to come in for a drink.¹ Experience will often provide evidence that the proverbial-worthy thought is true. The cost of whatever is advertised as free is recovered by being spread throughout the other merchandise of the business. There is no free lunch... Nothing comes for free...

Or is there something absolutely and completely free? The GIFT of God to us is eternal life through Jesus' death and resurrection. Nothing we think, nothing we say, nothing we do can pay the price for a single sin. Jesus took all our sin on Himself and nailed it to the cross. God gives us forgiveness as a gift. Freely, He offers it. Freely, He gives it. He gives the Holy Spirit so that hearing the gospel we believe it. We simply receive it. The word "free" does not appear in the Greek text of Romans 6:23. It is understood in the word "gift" (CHARISMA) as a gift given without merit or consideration of worthiness on the part of the recipient. **God gives because HE chooses to give.** Hearing the gospel of Jesus Christ, by grace the Holy Spirit creates faith in us to receive His word as truth. Today, God freely offers His salvation to you; freely receive it as His gift! His FREE GIFT!!
